CERT TRAINING POSTPONED

SEAL BEACH - The Cities of Buena Park, Cypress, La Palma, Los Alamitos, Seal Beach, and Westminster had scheduled a 20-hour Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training academy at JFTB-Los Alamitos on January 21-29, 2022. Out of an abundance of caution, we are postponing this academy to a future date, which is to be determined.

The CDC recommends limiting close contact and avoiding crowds as much as possible during the COVID-19 outbreak. By postponing this non-essential gathering, we can reduce the risk to CERT participants and allow cities and emergency agencies to focus on their primary response missions.
