## THE CITY OF SEAL BEACH ANNOUNCES PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED RATES FOR ANIMAL LICENSING FEES

Seal Beach, CA – To keep pace with inflation and the rising costs of providing safe, reliable, and effective animal control services, the City of Seal Beach is considering adopting a proposed resolution updating and establishing user and regulatory fees for animal control services, including dog licensing fees.

The public hearing will be held on Monday, January 22, 2024, at 7:00 pm at the Seal Beach City Council Chambers located at 211 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Seal Beach, CA 90740. Following the public hearing, the City Council will consider a proposed resolution to adopt the fees for animal control services, including dog licensing. This fee schedule will become effective upon adoption.

All interested persons are invited to attend and speak on this matter. Documents regarding the proposed fees, including the resolution and staff report, are on file and available for public review and may be accessed via the City Clerk's Office at City Hall, 211 8th Street, Seal Beach, CA 90740. All comments should be received before the start of the meeting, and all comments will be distributed to the City Council. The City will provide an opportunity for members of the public to provide public testimony to the City Council during the public hearing. If anyone wishes to challenge the City Council's action in court, they may be limited to raising only those issues they or anyone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk's Office at, or prior to, the public hearing.
